

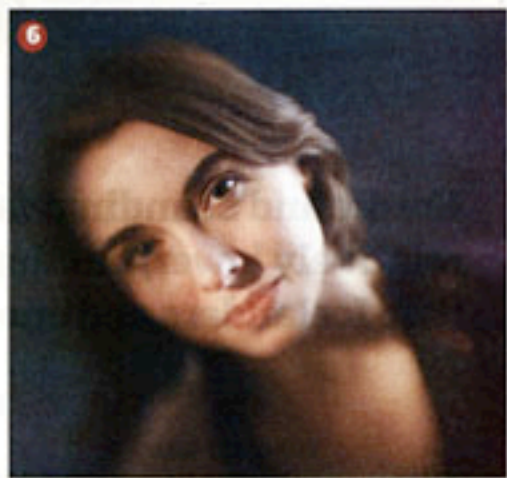

VANESSA VOSKUIL
dancer, choreographer, 30

What she's done: She caught our eye at the University of Minnesota, as much for her Old Dutch Masters visage as for her steely, resolute dancing. Since then she's developed acting chops as well as singular, cinematic smarts. Her imagistic "The White Solos" earned her a 2005 Sage Award in design. She's one of the founders of the poignant, provocative movement-theater group Live Action Set. She directed a Situationist experiment at the Northwestern Casket Co. building last year, which developed into this fall's "The Silents."

Why she's gonna make it: You will not find her in the performance mainstream. But see one of her compelling performances, interlaced with surrealist sensibility and bracing intelligence, and you won't forget her.

Where you can find her: With Stuart Pimsler Dance & Theater in March at the Ritz Theater, with Live Action Set in April at the Southern Theater, and back at the Ritz in late May, when Live Action Set, Ballet of the Dolls and Susana di Palma do a 21st-century version of "Rite of Spring."
